1. CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL / QUORUM DETERMINATION

- Steve Greene called the meeting to order at 11:00 a.m.
- Roll Call was conducted by Lisa Raffurty, 14 voting members present; quorum met.

4. MAIN CCESAB MEETING REVIEW

- Chief Carroll asked for clarification on the communication issues during the Southwest drill. Brad Handke stated the communication issues were related to police radios having encryption and multiple radios were missing XMTAC channels. In addition, many users need training; some not sure what is programmed in their radios. T.J. Martin agreed that it is a training issue.
- The County Interop template needs to be updated. The possibility of adding a zone for major incidents was discussed.
- Multiple agencies have MARCS and/or Cleveland programmed in their radios but never took the necessary steps to activate the appropriate ID's.
- The Committee will look into the creation of a "205 template" for major incidents.

5. GRANTS UPDATE

- Lezlie White stated that the 2022 UASI award is due back by November 23, 2023. She stated that a debriefing was requested to learn how they make the decisions.
- State Homeland 2022 Two Cuyahoga County projects were awarded. Cyber Security in the amount of \$213,060.00 and the Fusion Center Sustainment project in the amount of \$80,400 was received

6. RADIO APPLICATION REVIEW

- Highland Hills request Committee approval is not required for 2 radios being reallocated by Solon
- Brad Handke stated that Cleveland received the remaining radios Solon reallocated.
