Seeking an exemption to the procurement process for the current contracts listed here for the Staff Secure Shelter Care program. The Staff Secure Shelter Care program provides a residential alternative for youth who need 24-hour residential supervision to be considered for release from secure detention.

Shelter Care services has long been an integral part of the Juvenile Court Detention continuum as well as meeting the Juvenile Detention Alternative Initiative (Annie E Casey Foundation) core strategies to: eliminate the inappropriate or unnecessary use of secure detention; minimize re-arrest and failure-to-appear rates pending adjudication; ensure appropriate conditions of confinement in secure facilities; redirect public finances; and to reduce racial and ethnic disparities. These goals are also part of the Cuyahoga County Juvenile Court strategies as we move into our new facility. The shelter care contracts are funded through a combination of general fund, Title IV-E special revenue funds and RECLAIM Ohio funding.

The Shelter Care amendments considered here are for the period January 1, 2012 – December 31, 2012 and include:

- 1) Carrington Youth Academy, LLC, in the amount not-to-exceed an additional \$2,150,000.00;
