Cuyahoga County EMD Committee Meeting Minutes

August 13, 2012 - Brecksville Fire Department

- 1. In attendance: Chief Ed Egut, Nancy Kolcan, Marybeth Terwilliger, Nick Pishnery, Dan Reinholz, Betsy Kulp, Laura Hays
- 2. Overview of June Meeting
 - Briefly discussed APCO presentation from Dan Reinholz. Nancy is working on an overview of each presentation to be discussed at September meeting
 - Briefly discussed PSAP visits. At this time, a rough estimate of agencies interested in participating in an EMD program is about 15. The hope is that more will express an interest as the process moves forward.
- 3. Presentation by Eric Frey of Powerphone
 - Powerphone has trained over 190,000 dispatchers Worldwide
 - Training available for EMD, Fire and Police
 - People have an expectation of pre-arrival instructions based on media exposure
 - Powerphone feels that it has adequately addressed the challenges involved with putting an EMD program in place (ie: cost, availability and effectiveness of training)
 - Powerphone strives to enhance the diversity of each PSAP and their operations.
 - Powerphone "Total Response System" is based on training, protocol and QA/QI
 - Training is currently offered through in class instruction. On-line University due to go live in the next few weeks. Courses will then be offered on-line.
 - Initial certification requires successful completion of 24 hour class. No pre-requisites required.
 - Re-certification can be done on-line and is required every two years. Currently no continuing education required to re-certify.
 - Agencies can become "accredited" by Powerphone based on QA/QI. Agencies must also have SOP in place. Accredited at agency level. County can play role in this process.
 - Powerphone has upgraded its "books" to "tablets". Much more user friendly!
 - Updates for tablets are free and automatic
 - Tablets are customizable regarding response configurations
 - "CACHE" is the software program.
 - Can be stand alone or integrated with CAD
 - Appears to be very user friendly with no cluttering of screen or switching back and forth between several screens
 - Has ability to integrate SOP's.
 - Pricing includes Fire and Police dispatch.
