Records Management System (RMS) – continuing development of the MyCRIS applications; questions or problems should be directed to Help Desk.

Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) – review of product with Noris, more information will be available in November. Free application of E911 pilot CAD available, a host is needed. Norberto Colón added primary goal now for the CAD solution is working toward a cost model applicable to the existing budget, and within the current user fee structure.

 Advanced Authentication Status – application is in-house; working with Dept. of IT to set-up the project; kick-off will be scheduled next week followed by roll-out soon.
