Sherer stated that telcos assume 90 seconds as an average for 911 call duration. L. Raffurty agreed and added that the 90 second average would increase if doing EMD. S. Greene expressed interest in determining the current maximum ECW is configuring the system for.
- S. Greene shared N. DiCicco's inquiry on whether the County had given consideration to neighboring County's using the 911 system. The group discussed this possibility. B. Carney will inquire with

County. B. Emmons stated that other counties are hosted by different telcos which could create issues for sharing 911 system.

- Cleveland has submitted formal request to begin receiving their 911 calls directly.
