3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

 G. Balasko motioned to pass the minutes, seconded by R. Kimbro. Vote: 11 yes, 1 abstained. Motion passed.

4. HELICOPTER COMMUNICATIONS

 Motion made to accept recommendation and forward it to the Cuyahoga County and Northeast Ohio Fire Chief's Association of adoption. Motion made by Chief Flynn and seconded by R. Kimbro. Vote: 12 yes votes, motion passed. Chief Gilman to present to both associations. G. Blasko will present to the State Interoperability Emergency Communications.

5. MTAC CHANNELS FOR ODOT

Chief Gillman raised concern that ODOT does not have shared MARCS talkgroups and local
agencies are unable to communicate with them when there are needs for road closures and other
freeway activities. Gilman would like the ODOT supervisors to have a way to communicate with
those trying to mitigate a freeway incident. S. Garwood needs an email to request that so he can
forward that info to ODOT. B. Handke made the motion to have XMTAC talkgroups added to the
ODOT supervisor radios. Seconded by Chief Elliot. Vote 12 yes, motion passed

6. CACHE/COMMAND AND CONTROL RADIO UPDATE

• S. Garwood built template that he is ready to program into a few cache radios here in Independence. Localized talkgroups will not be in the cache radios but in command and control only. S. Garwood to email out the template once the final adjustments are made.

7. ANNOUNCEMENTS / OTHER BUSINESS

- Alternate Voting members discussed and changes made. January meeting will include voting in a new Chairman as Chief Flynn will be retiring.
- Grant money not yet released and guidance not yet released so we are unsure how the money can be spent.
- TICP was approved by the CCESAB except for an error on page 5 that needs to be fixed. It can then
 be sent on to the County Executive for signature.
- C. Bollinger mentioned that during protests radio jamming is a real threat.
- B. Handke stated that anyone wanting the Regionals can get them without a fee.
- MARCS testing needs to be reviewed as the response is less than a 40% response. L. Raffurty made a motion to eliminate the monthly testing as more agencies are on the 7.x and/or Cleveland thus the need to test is not necessary. Seconded by C. Haddon. 12 yes, motion passed
