- Training for radios was delayed due to waiting on available UASI funds but none was awarded. Furguson will make final adjustments to training.

News to come out around June. Rumors are around that the RNC money will be around for radios.
 We do not have any proof of that.

8. CACHE/COMMAND AND CONTROL RADIO UPDATE

- Cache radios are being completed and moving forward. Greene had issues with his keys so Garwood and Greene will program them today.
- 3.5 is still active because OSP has not moved over nor had the Ohio Dept of Health.
- Many hospitals are not moved over either.
- Full move off of 3.5 May not happen until after the RNC.

9. ANNOUNCEMENTS / OTHER BUSINESS

- CSU and CPD met to discuss housing for up to 3,000 LEO. Many colleges in the area are providing
 housing and CSU is the hub. A security zone will be established. Cleveland visiting bureau is setting
 up entertainment packages for families to have things to do during the RNC.
- Metro Lifeflight is looking for a talkgroup on the Cleveland system and approached Shaw about this. The thought was presented that the Cleveland Regionals, the xMTACs, and the XCUYCOs could be used and controlled by CECOMS much like the way that the old HEAR channels were used. Chief Shaw will ask Brandy Carney if CECOMS could provide this service.
