1. CALL TO ORDER

Chief Kenneth Ledford called the April 13, 2017 meeting of the Cuyahoga County Emergency Services Advisory Board to order.

2. ROLL CALL / QUORUM DETERMINATION

Roll was called and a quorum was in attendance.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT - None

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4. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES (February 9, 2017)

Motion to approve the meeting minutes of Feb. 9, 2017 made by Laura Palinkas; seconded by Alex Pellom; all in favor; none opposed; minutes approved.

Brandy Carney introduced Melinda Burt, Administrator with Public Safety & Justice Services. Noted Lisa Raffurty is new CECOMS Manager, and new initiative with PSJS, Criminal Justice Information Sharing.

5. OFFICE of EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT (OEM) UPDATE

Mark Christie gave an update on opposition to proposed legislation SB103; discussed Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) grant cuts. Countywide All Hazards Mitigation Plan ready for review and approval. Also noted were upcoming trainings, new staff in OEM.

6. PUBLIC SAFETY GRANTS

Jeff Harraman gave update on projects associated with open grants, SHSP FY2015, 2016, and UASI FY2016. No updates for SHSP and UASI FY2017 grants. Discussed new grant funding opportunities and applications made.

<u>Citizen Corps – Sharon Nicastro</u>

Reported on Community Organizations Active in Disaster (COAD), mission, structure and functions. Discussed planning for animals in a disaster, and other initiatives within COAD.

Communications – Chief Bill Shaw

Update on continuing template project, with pending vote of approval by CCESAB at next meeting. Awaiting bid release and review/test of radios from potential vendors.

EMS – Chief Bruce Elliott

Reported on an advocate component for committee meetings. Review of MCI Annex Plan done annually. Exploring projects for EMS. Update on regional EMS protocol development.

Fire - Chief Mike Carroll

Meeting scheduled for May 18th. Chief Galgas re-elected as Vice-Chair. Update on body armor.

Health & Medical - Beth Gatlin

Committee met with guest speakers from CEI, discussion on power loss at hospitals/facilities during high wind storms, and discrepancies in listings and notifications of who was without power and communications with Ohio EMA. Discussed projects for grant funding.

Public Works - Rob Jamieson

Discussed recent planning and countywide meetings to review emergency management topics for public works. All municipalities invited 26 in attendance with other government agencies. Reviewed disaster procedures manual and MARCS radio system and registering, reprogramming.
