 The committee agreed to approve the agreement with the following stipulations: Member(s) of TAC or their designee will participate in the review/approval of both the functional and technical specs once they are developed. Members – plural or their designee is stated that way so that the right resource(s) is allocated to the review. Because of the nature 	
 of the project it will involve development, infrastructure, and security skill sets. Security will review and approve the technical design. After go live, a 3rd party will be contracted per the terms already in the agreement to audit for security compliance. 	
Other items of discussion noted but no additional follow-up for the committee:	
 There is no language that outlines a payment schedule. It is understood the upfront costs are paid out upon contract execution, but afterwards there is nothing defined that communicates a payment schedule upon defined set of deliverables. Question arose regarding whether the DW should have gone out for bid. There is language included in the agreement making assumptions of participating organizations/agencies. Assumption is that any data participation will be discussed and approved by the owning organization
