- **1. CALL TO ORDER** Co-Chairman: Beth Gatlin called the meeting of the Health & Medical Functional Committee to order, September 29, 2017 @1015

- 5. THIRA DISCUSSION and update-Review of the UASI goals #9 and #10 completed with changes discussed and documented. It was felt Goal #11 was not in the medical scope so was not discussed. Discussion of the Health and Medical part of the THIRA completed except for the Mass Fatality portion due to no medical examiner office representative as SME at the meeting. Will resend for ME input and any revisions if needed will be forwarded to the OEM. Specifications for the space needed for a Regional Node for MCM countermeasures and for the Fleet Medical Stations will be sent to the EMA to assist with finding a brick and mortar facility and well as to assist with developing an MOU for its use in a disaster.

## \*EXECUTIVE SESSION MAY BE HELD PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE (ORC) 121.22(G)

ORC 121.22(G)(5), a public body may hold an executive session to consider "[m]atters required to be kept confidential by federal law or regulations or state statues." ORC 121.22(G)(6) provides that consideration of "[d]etails relative to the security arrangements and emergency response protocols for a public body or a public office, if disclosure of the matters discussed could reasonably be expected to jeopardize the security of the public body or a public office." Under this exception, both conditions must be met.

<sup>(1)</sup> the subject of the meeting must relate to the security arrangements and emergency response protocols for a public body or a public office; and,

<sup>(2)</sup> public disclosure of the matters discussed could reasonably be expected to jeopardize the security of that public body or public office.
