- Tafe updated 2018 approval of the award is with the State. Approval should be any time. Brad asked if this was a new bid. Tafe said yes but without an evaluation.
- Rega asked about the other grants. Tafe said that the Grants department expects that approval to come through. Harraman said that the purchase is for 2016 UASI, 2017 UASI and 2018 Homeland grants should go through with the State shortly.
- South Euclid purchase could include the radios interested by Walton Hills.
- If there are any issues, Cleveland Heights could be removed until next grants.
