1. CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL / QUORUM DETERMINATION

Called to order by Steven Greene at 11:08 a.m. Roll Call conducted, by Lisa Raffurty at 11:10 a.m. 18 voting members present, quorum met.

3. APPROVAL OF SEPTEMBER 9th MEETING MINUTES

Adam Griffith reported the TIC-P maps have been updated. Steve Greene asked if there is a motion to approve the TIC-PLAN. T.J. Martin motioned the approval of TIC Plan as written with the latest corrections, Randy Kimbro seconded the motion; all in favor. Motion carried, plan approved.

Steve Greene announced the committee will take nominations for Vice-Chair on January 13th. Election for the Vice-Chair will take place on that date.

Nick DiCicco reported that some cities are saying that radios are not holding up, he asked if those make/model radios can be disqualified. Lezlie White advised the County cannot keep disqualifying radio suppliers because it could run the risk of not having enough bidders. Lezlie also advised if an agency is replacing a radio they must follow the process of turning grant radios back in to the County.

Steve Greene advised the radio rebid was posted October 13th and closes today. Larry Tafe confirmed the bid closed today at 11am, radios were requested for Shaker Heights PD, Oakwood Village, Walton Hills, Beachwood PD, University Hts. PD, Lyndhurst PD and East Cleveland PD. Lezlie White said that, "we can't keep disqualifying radio suppliers based on functions because the state could run into not enough bids." She also said, that "radios can't just be turned in for something else. A process has to be followed."

Craig Bollinger suggested putting together a spreadsheet of radio functionality issues as a point of reference.
