- 2. Proposed specifications for county-wide 9-1-1 system assessment: Lindy reviewed the proposed specifications for the RFP that was completed by the 9-1-1 TAC Ad-Hoc committee. Motion to approve Specs was made and seconded. Motion approved.
- Amendments to 9-1-1 Plan: Nancy reviewed proposed wording for 2 additional members to be added to 9-1-1 TAC Committee. New members described as follows:
 - Public Safety Answering Point Regional (a consolidated center of five or more primary PSAPs)
 - Public Safety Answering Point most populous municipal corporation in Cuyahoga County.

Nancy reviewed changes through-out the plan to reflect PSAP consolidations since Plan approval in February. All changes approved for presentation to 9-1-1 Planning Committee.
