Fake Job Scams are common but there are these are the signs to know so you can avoid working for a scammer. Employers will NEVER:

- Ask you to deposit a check and then send funds -- in any form -- to someone else
- Create a bank or cryptocurrency account to work for them
- Accept or make payments by money wire, retail gift cards or cryptocurrency
- Accept and reship mail or packages
