Government Agencies Don't Ask For Payments in Bitcoin

Get a call or email telling you that you need to pay a bill, fine or fee with bitcoin? It is a <u>SCAM</u>. Utilities, jails and government agencies do not ask for payment in bitcoin, scammers do.

Bitcoin Payments Are Final

Once you send bitcoin to another person you cannot get your money back. Be wary of new online "friends" who ask you to help them by sending bitcoin.
