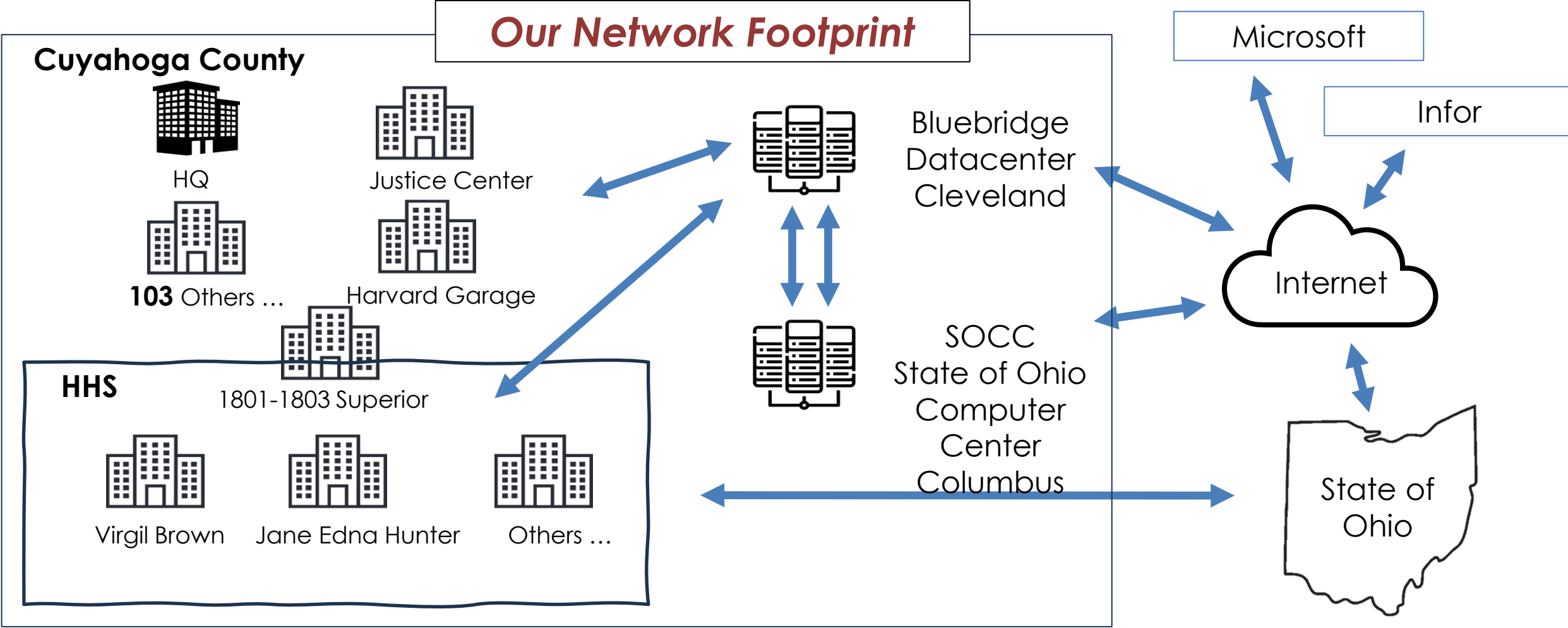

- \$0.1m (net) in 2027 covered by reductions in consulting and licensing (no budget increase requested)

- ① 2025 Forecast reflects 1x \$1.0m Infor Licensing delayed payment (Invoice moved from Oct 2025 to Jan 2026)
- ② 2026-2027 General Fund increases from Microsoft (\$0.7m), Infor (\$0.3m), and AT&T (\$0.1m) are offset by HHS chargebacks for mobile phone and Infor (\$0.7m) and reduction in consulting services & licenses (\$0.4)
- ③ 2026 HHS Budget increased due to 1x infrastructure refresh of equipment to County Data Center
