1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairwoman Turner called the meeting to order at 1:05 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE MARCH 30, 2026 MEETING

A motion was made by Mr. Schleper, seconded by Mr. Casselberry and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes from the March 30, 2026 meeting.

5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE

- a) R2026-0188: A Resolution amending the 2026/2027 Biennial Operating Budget for 2026 by providing additional fiscal appropriations from the General Fund and Health and Human Services Levies, to meet the budgetary needs of various County departments; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Mr. Walter Parfejewiec, Director of the Office of Budget and Management; and Ms. Dominique Tatum, Manager of Business Services, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2026-0188. Discussion ensued.
