- c) R2024-0167: A Resolution authorizing an amendment to Contract No. 3013 with Lutheran Metropolitan Ministry for operations and case management services for a 400-bed Men’s Emergency Shelter, located at 2100 Lakeside Avenue, Cleveland, and for facilitation and coordination of overflow shelter services for single adults and families at various locations for the period 1/1/2023 – 12/31/2024, to expand the scope of services and change the terms, and for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$4,350,000.00, effective upon contract signature of all parties; authorizing the County Executive to execute the amendment and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.
  
- d) R2024-0168: A Resolution authorizing an amendment to Contract No. 3272 (fka Contract No. 2730) with Emerald Development and Economic Network, Inc. for Rapid Re-housing and housing stabilization services for the period 1/1/2022 – 6/30/2024 to extend the time period to 12/31/2025, to change the terms, and for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$1,985,300.00, effective upon contract signature of all parties; authorizing the County Executive to execute the amendment and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.
