<p>Sponsored by: <b>Councilmembers Conwell and Houser</b></p>	<p><b>A Resolution</b> awarding a total sum, not to exceed \$12,500, to the Cuyahoga County Department of Health and Human Services for the Your Voice Matters Youth Voting Summit from the District 7 and District 10 ARPA Community Grant Funds; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.</p>
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**WHEREAS**, Cuyahoga County received \$239,898,257 from the Federal Government through the American Rescue Plan Act (“ARPA”); and

**WHEREAS**, Cuyahoga County calculated 100% of the ARPA dollars as loss revenue under the U.S. Department of the Treasury Final Rule; and

**WHEREAS**, since all the ARPA dollars have been calculated as loss revenue, the ARPA dollars have been deposited in the County’s General Fund; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Executive and County Council have authorized \$86 million of the ARPA dollars for community grants to benefit the residents of Cuyahoga County (the “ARPA Community Grant Fund”); and

**WHEREAS**, of the \$86 million for community grants, \$66 million have been encumbered for equal distribution to each County Council District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cuyahoga County Council desires to provide funding from the District 7 ARPA Community Grant Fund in the amount of \$10,000 and the District 10 ARPA Community Grant Fund in the amount of \$2,500 for a total amount of \$12,500 to the Cuyahoga County Department of Health and Human Services for the Your Voice Matters Youth Voting Summit; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cuyahoga County Department of Health and Human Services estimates approximately 300 people will be served annually through this award; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cuyahoga County Department of Health and Human Services estimates the total cost of the project is \$12,500; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cuyahoga County Department of Health and Human Services is estimating the start date of the project will be March 2026 and the project will be completed by September 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cuyahoga County Department of Health and Human Services requested \$12,500 from the District 8 ARPA Community Grant Fund to complete this project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cuyahoga County Council desires to provide funding in the amount of \$12,500 to the Cuyahoga County Department of Health and Human Services to ensure this project is completed; and

**WHEREAS**, this Council by a vote of at least eight (8) members determines that it is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue to provide for the usually, daily operations of the County.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Cuyahoga County Council hereby awards a not-to-exceed amount of \$12,500 to the Cuyahoga County Department of Health and Human Services from the General Fund made available by the American Rescue Plan Act revenue replacement provision for the Your Voice Matters Youth Voting Summit.

**SECTION 2.** If any specific appropriation is necessary to effectuate this agreement, the Director of the Office of Budget and Management is authorized to submit the requisite documentation to financial reporting to journalize the appropriation.

**SECTION 3.** That the County Council staff is authorized to prepare all documents to effectuate said award.

**SECTION 4.** That the County Executive is authorized to execute all necessary agreements and documents consistent with said award and this Resolution.

**SECTION 5.** If requested or necessary, the Agency of the Inspector General or Department of Internal Audit is authorized to investigate, audit, or review any part of this award.

**SECTION 6.** To the extent that any exemptions are necessary under the County Code and contracting procedures, they shall be deemed approved by the adoption of this Resolution.

**SECTION 7.** It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective for the usual daily operation of the County; the preservation of public

peace, health or safety in the County; and any additional reasons set forth in the preamble. Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least eight members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon the earliest occurrence of any of the following: (1) its approval by the County Executive through signature, (2) the expiration of the time during which it may be disapproved by the County Executive under Section 3.10(6) of the Cuyahoga County Charter, or (3) its passage by at least eight members of Council after disapproval pursuant to Section 3.10(7) of the Cuyahoga County Charter. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

**SECTION 8.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Your Voice Matters Youth Voting Summit: 10th Anniversary Branding Initiative**

**REQUEST DESCRIPTION (include the project name, a description of the project, why the project is important or needed, and timeline of milestones/tracking of the project):**

**Funding Request:** \$12,500 for Commemorative Participant Apparel and Full-Service Catering.

**Description of the Project** This request seeks \$12,500 to produce high-quality catering and professional branded materials for 300 participants and attendees of the 10th Anniversary **Your Voice Matters Youth Voting Summit**. Nutritious catering ensures all three hundred participants remain energized and focused throughout the summit’s full day of civic education. These t-shirts will serve as the official "uniform" for the event, creating a unified visual identity at the Alex B. Johnson Campus Center. By providing these to our 16–19-year-old leaders, we transform a one-day event into a lasting movement.

**Why the Project is Important:** As we celebrate a decade of civic impact, these materials and resources are essential tools for long-term brand recognition and meaningful community engagement:

- **Nutritional Support & Engagement:** Providing high-quality food and beverages ensures that all 300 participants remain energized and focused throughout a full day of intensive civic learning. By meeting these basic needs on-site, we create a hospitable environment where students can fully commit to the program without distraction.
- **Visual Equity:** The branded apparel serves as a professional "uniform." By providing the same high-quality shirts to every participant, we ensure all 250 student leaders feel like equal members of a prestigious delegation, regardless of their background.
- **Walking Billboards:** Long after the September 29th summit, these shirts act as a recurring advertisement for civic engagement within Cuyahoga County high schools and neighborhoods.
- **Message Sustainability:** These shirts turn a one-day event into a lasting movement. As students wear them in their daily lives, they spark peer-to-peer conversations about the democratic process, keeping the "Voicing Our Vote" mission visible for years to come.

## IMPACT OF PROJECT:

### Who will be served:

The project primary serves **high school students (ages 16–19)** across Cuyahoga County, specifically targeting emerging leaders and potential first-time voters. We also serve community partners, educators, and regional stakeholders who participate in the summit to mentor and guide these youth.

### How many people will be served annually:

Approximately **300 individuals** will be served directly through the annual summit, including 250 student delegates and 50 staff, volunteers, and guest speakers.

### Will low/moderate income people be served; if so how:

**Yes.** The project specifically identifies and recruits students from zip codes with historically low voter turnout and higher concentrations of low-to-moderate income households. By providing free registration, professional-grade materials, and commemorative apparel, we remove the financial barriers to high-level civic training. This ensures that a student's economic background does not limit their ability to participate in the democratic process or develop leadership skills.

### How does the project fit with the community and with other ongoing projects:

The **Your Voice Matters Youth Voting Summit** is a cornerstone of the **Cuyahoga County Department of Health and Human Services (HHS)** mission to foster stable, self-sufficient, and civically engaged households. This project creates a seamless bridge between social services and civic engagement by aligning with the following regional initiatives:

- **Cuyahoga Community College (Tri-C):** By hosting the summit at the Alex B. Johnson Campus Center, we introduce high school students to a collegiate environment, supporting County goals for post-secondary enrollment and workforce readiness.
- **The National Council of Jewish Women (NCJW) & NOVA:** We collaborate with these advocacy leaders to provide high-quality, non-partisan voter education that meets the highest standards of accuracy and inclusivity.
- **The Urban League of Greater Cleveland:** We connect civic engagement with essential stability services, proving that a "sustainable lifestyle" requires a political voice.

Through these strategic collaborations, the summit moves beyond a one-day event. It serves as a coordinated effort across HHS and its partners to eliminate barriers to participation, strengthen the civic fabric, and ensure every resident in Cuyahoga County has the tools to navigate the democratic process.

### If applicable, how many jobs will be created or retained (specify the number for each) and will the jobs be permanent or temporary:

While this project does not create permanent new positions, it **retains and supports the professional development** of existing county staff and community organizers by providing a platform for large-scale project management. It also supports local vendors, such as Echographics, for the production of event materials.

**If applicable, what environmental issues or benefits will there be:**

We prioritize sustainability by using digital RSVP systems and electronic distribution of educational materials where possible. By investing in high-quality, 3-color screen-printed apparel rather than "single-use" promotional items, we provide a durable product that stays out of landfills and remains useful for years.

**If applicable, how does this project serve as a catalyst for future initiatives:**

The summit acts as a **civic incubator**. By training 250 youth leaders, we create a "ripple effect" where students return to their schools to lead their own voter registration drives. This 10th-anniversary milestone also serves as a model for future regional health and wellness events, proving that targeted, high-energy engagement can successfully bridge the gap between residents and local government.
