# 1. CALL TO ORDER

#### 5. NEW BUSINESS

a) Presentation by ACLU of Ohio

Ms. Gabriella Celeste, Policy Director of the Schubert Center for Child Studies at Case Western Reserve University; Ms. Jocelyn Rosnick, Policy Director for ACLU of Ohio; and Mr. Patrick Gleydura, Policy Strategist for ACLU of Ohio, presented the Committee with information regarding youth crime trends, youth challenges, potential strategies to reduce youth crime and the findings from the Youth Focus Group Project. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Ms. Celeste, Ms. Rosnick and Mr. Gleydura pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

b) Discussion regarding final report
