

Challenges

- Reorganization of each Office, specifically given the technical nature of 911 and Law Enforcement Data Sharing
- Organizing and ensuring compliance with the many different grants administered by Justice Affairs

Accomplishments

- Initiated discussions with the City of Cleveland Department of Public Safety, Office of Information Technology to discuss leveraging City and County public safety IT resources
- Proposed a formal partnership between the City of Cleveland Office of Emergency Management and Cuyahoga County Office of Emergency Management for use of the City of Cleveland's Emergency Operations Center and resources during emergency and non-emergency events
- Began quarterly meetings with the Cuyahoga County Police Chief's Association and Fire Chief's Association
- Coordinated the 11th annual Juvenile Crime Coalition Conference. The conference had
 288 attendees from various agencies and organizations throughout the county
- Relocated the Cuyahoga County Office of Emergency Management from the Marion Building to Courthouse Square
- Facilitated the collection of PSAP data to evaluate 9-1-1 equipment and capabilities within Cuyahoga County. The results of this study will be used to update 9-1-1 equipment and encourage consolidation of the 47 PSAPS throughout the County.
