#### 2013 Selected Accomplishments


- Awarded Federal Second Chance Act funding for 3<sup>rd</sup> year in a row
- Fully implemented three Social Enterprise programs in partnership with the Cleveland Foundation
  - Generated three new businesses: The Central Kitchen; Expert Reclaim, Inc. and Signatures Style Lounge. 25 job placements; 86 enrolled as current/immediate next class
- Developed Family Programs at North Star: Family Matters & Reentry Reconnection
- Increased Collaboration with ODRC and Ohio Reentry Coalition: Three-Tier System; Prison Reintegration Centers; Reentry Fairs; Reentry Summit
- Developed Reentry Transition Model to strengthen focus on earlier pre-release service contacts, community linkage and follow-up

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### 2013 Service Highlights

- The North Star Reentry Resource Center
  - As of 10/31/13:
    - Total Service Contacts: 16,990 (first time+ repeat visits)
    - 5, 907 clients used the Computer Lab
    - 208 got voicemail boxes
    - 975 bus passes used
    - 1,471 New memberships
    - 3,176 hours in Service Provider and Member volunteer hours; 757 different groups and classes held
