• A brief overview of your recommended 2020-2021 biennial budget

The FCFC budget is divided into two state mandated areas. Service Coordination and Child-well Being/Youth Development.

The State funds cover 89% of our Service Coordination component. The remaining 11% is covered by local funds. Local funding is used as a safety net for families that do not meet the criteria for the State funds but are still in need of assistance.

The Child-well Being/Youth Development services are 100% levy funded. The funds support: Out-of-School Time and Transitions, Youth Leadership/Engagement, Comprehensive Sexual Education, Youth Internships, Parent/Family Engagement, and Closing the Achievement Gap.
