1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairwoman Simon called the meeting to order at 2:13 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Ms. Simon asked Assistant Deputy Clerk Carter to call the roll. Committee members Simon, Hairston, Germana and Connally were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Committee member Schron was absent from the meeting. Councilmember Miller was also in attendance.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT RELATED TO THE AGENDA

No public comments were given.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE JUNE 4, 2014 MEETING

A motion was made by Ms. Connally, seconded by Mr. Germana and approved unanimous vote to approve the minutes of the June 4, 2014 meeting.

- 5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
 - a) R2014-0171: A Resolution making awards on RQ30142 to various providers for Workforce Investment Act Youth Training for the period 7/1/2014 6/30/2015; authorizing the County Executive to execute the agreements and contracts and all other documents consistent with said awards and this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective:
 - 1) In-School:

- a) Baldwin-Wallace College in the amount not-to-exceed \$110,000.00.
- b) Cuyahoga Community College District in the amount not-to-exceed \$350,000.00.
- c) Esperanza in the amount not-to-exceed \$178,000.00.
- d) OhioGuidestone in the amount not-to-exceed \$177,659.00.
- e) Linking Employment Abilities and Potential in the amount not-to-exceed \$105,700.00.
- f) Mayfield City School District in the amount not-to-exceed \$216,813.00
- g) Open Doors Academy in the amount not-to-exceed \$250,000.00.
- h) Youth Opportunities Unlimited in the amount not-to-exceed \$374,230.00.

2) Out-of-School:

- a) Cuyahoga Community College District in the amount not-to-exceed \$215,000.00.
- b) OhioGuidestone in the amount not-to-exceed \$465,000.00.

3) Youth Resource Center Operator:

- a) Towards Employment, Incorporated in the amount not-to-exceed \$100,000.00.
- b) Youth Opportunities Unlimited in the amount not-to-exceed \$112,500.00.

4) Connecting the Dots Foster Care Provider:

a) OhioGuidestone in the amount not-to-exceed \$500,000.00.

Ms. Simon addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2014-0171. Discussion ensued.

Ms. Jayanti Bhattacharya, Deputy Director and Chief Financial Officer of the Department of Workforce Development, and Ms. Candace James, Youth Program Manager, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2014-0171. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Ms. Bhattacharya and Ms. James pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

On a motion by Ms. Simon with a second by Ms. Connally, Resolution No. R2014-0171 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda with a recommendation for passage under second reading suspension of the rules.

Mr. Miller announced that the Cleveland Orchestra will perform on Public Square this evening for the "Star Spangled Spectacular."

Ms. Simon reported that she is currently working on legislation regarding hiring a sustainability manager for the County and will have discussions in Committee in the next few weeks.
