1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairwoman Conwell called the meeting to order at 1:03 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Ms. Conwell asked Assistant Deputy Clerk Culek to call the roll. Committee members Conwell, Tuma, Baker, Brown and Miller were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Councilmember Brady was also in attendance.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT RELATED TO THE AGENDA

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE MAY 31, 2017 MEETING

A motion was made by Ms. Brown, seconded by Mr. Tuma and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes from the May 31, 2017 meeting.

- 5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
 - a) R2017-0115: A Resolution authorizing amendments to contracts with various providers for the Teen Pregnancy Prevention Program for the period 11/1/2015 12/31/2016 to extend the time period to 12/31/2017 and for additional funds; authorizing the County Executive to execute the amendments and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective:

- 1) No. CE1500342-01 with Beech Brook in the amount not-to-exceed \$10,000.00.
- 2) No. CE1500343-01 with Planned Parenthood of Greater Ohio, Inc. in the amount not-to-exceed \$20,000.00.
