

MINUTES CUYAHOGA COUNTY COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE MEETING TUESDAY, MARCH 12, 2019 CUYAHOGA COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE HEADQUARTERS C. ELLEN CONNALLY COUNCIL CHAMBERS – 4TH FLOOR 4:30 PM

1. CALL TO ORDER

Council President Brady called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL
