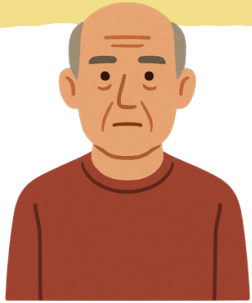


Newly Work Required Individuals aged 60-64



**Are you a SNAP recipient age 60-64?
Did you know that you now have to meet
a SNAP Work Requirement?**



DO YOU FALL INTO ONE OF THESE CATEGORIES?

- ✓ Pregnant
- ✓ Assistance group contains a child under age 14
- ✓ Indian, Urban Indian, or California Indian
- ✓ Physically or Mentally unfit for employment
- ✓ Caring for an incapacitated person
- ✓ Applying for or receiving Unemployment Compensation

- ✓ Participating in a drug/alcohol treatment program
- ✓ Enrolled in school/training half-time or more
- ✓ Working 30 hrs/week (or equivalent pay)

**If You Don't Fall Into One
of the Categories Above,
THEN YOU ARE A WORK
REQUIRED ABLE-BODIED ADULT**



Limited to receiving SNAP benefits for 3 months in a 3-year period unless you complete and document at least 20 hours per week (80 hours/month) of a work activity. Approved work activities include:

- ✓ **Paid Employment (<https://greaterclevelandworks.org/>)**
- ✓ **Qualified training, such as the voluntary SNAP Employment and Training Program**
- ✓ **Community Service (<https://greaterclevelandvolunteers.org>)****
