Are you a SNAP recipient and have recently aged out of foster care?



Did you know that you now have to meet a SNAP Work Requirement?

DO YOU FALL INTO ONE OF THESE CATEGORIES?

- ☒ **Pregnant**
- ☒ **Assistance group contains a child under age 14**
- ☒ **Indian, Urban Indian, or California Indian**
- ☒ **Physically or Mentally unfit for employment**
- ☒ **Caring for an incapacitated person**
- ☒ **Applying for or receiving Unemployment Compensation**

- ☒ **Participating in a drug/alcohol treatment program**
- ☒ **Enrolled in school/training half-time or more**
- ☒ **Working 30 hrs/week (or equivalent pay)**

If You Don't Fall Into One of the Categories Above, THEN YOU ARE A WORK REQUIRED ABLE-BODIED ADULT



Limited to receiving SNAP benefits for 3 months in a 3-year period unless you complete and document at least 20 hours per week (80 hours/month) of a work activity.

APPROVED WORK ACTIVITIES INCLUDE:
