**TO MAINTAIN ELIGIBILITY FOR SNAP BENEFITS,
MEET ONE OF THESE SNAP WORK REQUIREMENT EXEMPTIONS*:**

- ✓ Caring for a child under age 6
- ✓ Applied for SSI and SNAP at the Social Security Office
- ✓ Working 30 hrs/week (or equivalent pay)
- ✓ Physically or Mentally unfit for employment
- ✓ Participation in a Drug or Alcohol Treatment Program
- ✓ Enrolled in school/training half-time or more

DON'T MEET AN EXEMPTION?

Then You Are Considered a Work Required Able-Bodied Adult



Limited to receiving SNAP benefits for 3 months in a 3-year period unless you complete and document at least 20 hours per week (80 hours/month) of a work activity.
