

PUBLIC NOTICE: CUYAHOGA URBAN COUNTY FY2026 ACTION PLANS

The National Affordable Housing Act of 1990 (Housing Act) as amended and implemented through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) regulations at 24 CFR 91, requires local governments to submit an Annual Action Plan. The Action Plan is an application for three programs administered by Cuyahoga County through the Department of Housing and Community Development. These programs are the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), and the HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) program. The FY 2026 application enables the County to access and use new funding of more than \$7,000,000.

The Housing Act also enabled the cities of Cleveland Heights, Euclid, Lakewood, and Parma to join with the Urban County to form the Cuyahoga Housing Consortium (Consortium), to submit a coordinated application for HOME funding. Each of these cities is currently developing an Annual Action Plan for their respective jurisdictions and are conducting citizen participation processes in their communities.

Cuyahoga County will hold a public meeting to discuss and receive comments on housing, community development needs, and programs in the suburban communities served by the County's HUD programs for the FY 2026 Annual Action Plan.
