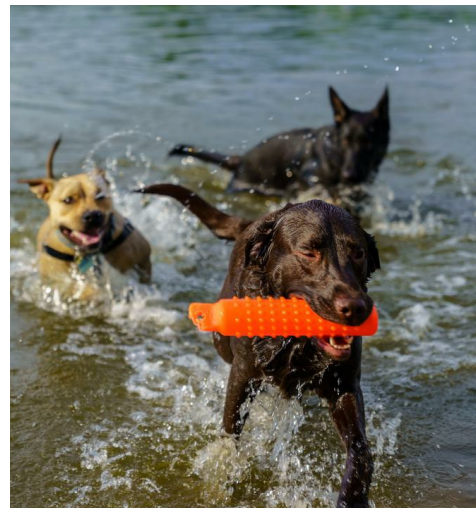
## Cuyahoga County Resources, Services and Information for You



### Cuyahoga County Restaurant Stabilization Fund Live NOW

An additional \$1.2 million has been added to the County's Small Business Stabilization Fund specifically for restaurants impacted by the pandemic. Grants of up to \$10,000 are available to restaurants in the County for unpaid rent, utilities and COVID-19 safety-related costs incurred from March 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020. Grants will be administered by Destination Cleveland and distributed by Cleveland Neighborhood Progress. Applications are open now and will close December 11 at 5:00 p.m.

### Dog License Enrollment and Renewal Open

Open enrollment and renewal of dog licenses in Cuyahoga County is available now through January 31, 2021. Ohio law requires dog owners to renew their dog license each year--these licenses help support Cuyahoga County Animal Shelter operations. There are many ways to purchase or renew a license, including online, by mail, or at one of many neighborhood locations. Having a license for your dog isn't only a law, it's also a lost dog's ticket home!

### Home Energy Assistance Programs Can Keep You Warm This Winter

Home Energy Assistance Programs (HEAP) can help residents at or below 175 percent of the federal poverty guidelines to pay their heating bills. The benefit is applied directly to the customer's utility or bulk fuel bill after January 1, helping to manage heating costs through the winter. HEAP is currently accepting applications and the County's Division of Senior and Adult Services (DSAS) can assist eligible County residents ages 60 and over (and adults 18-59 with disabilities) with this program through a grant from the Ohio Department of Aging.
