Mortgage Assistance Available NOW

County homeowners who have been impacted by COVID-19 may be eligible for mortgage payment assistance.

County Council approved \$2 million of the County CARES Act funding received through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD)

Community Development Block Grant program to provide a one-time, zero interest deferred loan to urban County homeowners who meet HUD eligibility guidelines and who have difficulty paying their mortgages because of the financial impact of COVID-19. Assistance is available while funds last.

County Executive Issues Executive Orders Elevating Opportunities for Minority Owned Businesses

County Executive Armond Budish has issued a set of executive orders aimed at instituting a more robust race and gender-conscious program within Cuyahoga County's procurement procedures. The Executive Orders address findings from a 2020 disparity study which revealed that, despite good efforts by the County, there is a disparity between the number of available Minority and Women Business Enterprises and the number of those firms that have been awarded contracts from the County.
