

Internal Equity Commission Releases First Report

The Cuyahoga County Internal Equity Commission has released its first Equity Report to the community. This Commission is staffed by the heads of several County agencies and examined current County policies and protocols, how they affect different populations and how they can be improved and made more accessible. Free Tax Preparation Services

Cuyahoga County and the Cuyahoga Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) Coalition, led by Enterprise Community Partners, will host free tax preparation services February 12 through April 15, 2021. The free tax preparation services will be available virtually or at 11 different drop-off/pick-up locations across the county. Working families may be eligible to receive up to \$6,600 through the Earned Income Tax Credit. The program offers free tax help to families and individuals who generally make \$57,000 or less, persons with disabilities, and limited English-speaking taxpayers who need assistance in preparing their own tax returns. Translation and interpretation services, as well as free financial counseling, are also available.
