Vaccination Sites and Free Public Transportation

COVID-19 vaccinations are becoming more widely available in Cuyahoga County, and there are dozens of locations currently administering vaccines. If you're eligible, you can visit the state's website to register, or you can call United Way of Greater Cleveland's 2-1-1 Help Line. If access to transportation is a barrier for you, 2-1-1 can also provide you with options for free transportation to a vaccination site.

Property Valuation Complaints Due March 31

The County Board of Revision is accepting Complaint Forms to protest your property valuation for tax year 2020 through March 31, 2021 at 4:30 p.m. There are several ways to obtain and return a complaint form, including online, hard copy and in-person. The Board of Revision website provides additional instructions and examples of different types of evidence you can submit that relate to your type of property and support your opinion of value. The more evidence you provide to the board, the stronger your case.
