Cleveland is in the top 5 in the U.S. for Gaining Net New Residents Since the Onset of the Pandemic

Fresh data shows that Cleveland is ranked as one of the top cities that made the biggest gains in attracting net new residents since April 2020. In a study of 38 major U.S. metropolitan areas, conducted by LinkedIn's Economic Graph team, Cleveland ranked fifth in attracting new arrivals behind cities, such as Salt Lake City and Jacksonville, Fla. Engage! Cleveland, a community engagement organization focused on attracting, engaging, and retaining talent to the region, has been advertising assets such as Cleveland's spacious geography, affordable housing prices and low cost of living reaching more than 2 million young professionals nationwide since June 2020 with its "Discover Cleveland" marketing campaign.

Avoiding Vaccine Email Survey Scams and Contact Tracing Scams

The Cuyahoga County Department of Consumer Affairs and Cuyahoga County Board of Health (CCBH) are warning the public to avoid two COVID-19 scams reported by County residents. One scam is an emailed “survey” that baits people into participating by offering bogus \$90 rewards for sharing their opinions about the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines. **Do not open or click on any links on the email, including the unsubscribe button.** The other is a phone scam in which an imposter contact tracer asks people for their Social Security number. Legitimate contact tracers never request Social Security numbers or payment information.

RFP for County-Wide Employee Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Training

Cuyahoga County has released a Request for Proposal (RFP) to provide Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) training to all Cuyahoga County employees following the recommendation of the Cuyahoga County Equity Commission and the Citizens’ Advisory Council on Equity. The Citizens’ Advisory Council on Equity and the County’s internal Equity Commission were established in July 2020 after Cuyahoga County passed legislation declaring racism a public health crisis. The purpose of the RFP is to develop and execute a training and education strategy that will increase the awareness, knowledge, and skills of Cuyahoga County staff, boards, and commissions as it pertains to diversity, equity, and inclusion.
