County Launches New Property Sales Locator

Cuyahoga County has launched a new Property Sales Locator for residents and community members to explore all home sales in Cuyahoga County from 2018-2021. The Fiscal Office Hub contains data on parcels in the County, an app with all recent sales information in the County and information on the property valuation process. The Sales Finder App allows users to search by parcel number or address within a selected radius and export this data. Users can also filter by year or by land-use type.

Dog License Open Enrollment

Cuyahoga County's 2022 dog license open enrollment period runs from December 1 to January 31. Having a license for your dog isn't only a law, but it's also a lost dog's ticket home. When your dog has its license attached to its collar, its assigned license number is all that is necessary for the County to identify the dog's owner. If you do not buy your dog's license during this renewal period, Ohio law requires a late fee equal to the cost of the license.
