### County Proposes Funding for Five New Affordable Housing Projects

Cuyahoga County has proposed an investment of \$2.2 million for the creation of five affordable housing projects in Cleveland, Cleveland Heights and Maple Heights. The funding will help create 309 new affordable housing units. COVID has made it more clear than ever the importance of affordable housing availability in Cuyahoga County. If approved by County Council, construction is anticipated to begin in the next year.
