Cuyahoga County Announces Third and Fourth Rounds of American Rescue Plan Funding

Cuyahoga County Executive Armond Budish and members of Cuyahoga County Council have announced the third and fourth rounds of initiatives proposed for funding using American Rescue Plan (ARPA) dollars. These initiatives amount to more than \$161 million in ARPA funding, bringing the announcement total thus far to over \$219 million. Over 3,400 Trees to be Planted in Cuyahoga County through Third Round of Healthy Tree Canopy Grant Program

In its third year of Urban Tree Canopy Grant Program awards, Cuyahoga County will invest \$950,000 into its tree canopy by funding 27 projects for tree plans and tree planting sponsored by area municipalities, neighborhoods, and nonprofits. Over 3,400 trees will be planted during the third round, which will bring the total number of trees planted across all three rounds to over 7,500.
