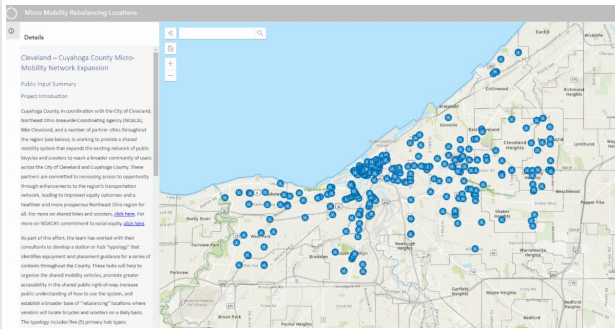

### Cuyahoga County Seeking Public Comment on Scooter Infrastructure Expansion Program

Cuyahoga County is committed to making it easier for residents to get around their neighborhoods. As part of this effort, the County and partners have identified locations for bike and scooter “rebalancing hubs” (or parking locations) throughout the county. These hubs will provide equipment to organize scooters and e-bikes when not in use. Residents can visit an interactive map, linked in the above image, to explore the proposed locations for rebalancing stations and provide feedback and comments. Public comment will be open until Friday, September 30, 2022.

### Public Service Student Loan Forgiveness

Are you a public service employee with student loan debt? If so, there’s a chance you could reduce the amount you owe! For a limited time, public service employees who are repaying federal student loans can apply for a waiver that could eliminate a portion of their debt. The Public Service Loan Forgiveness (PSLF) program lets employees in public service have their federal student loan debts forgiven after 120 qualifying payments. A new, time-limited waiver lets borrowers get credit for some loan payments that didn’t count toward forgiveness before. The deadline to apply is October 31.
