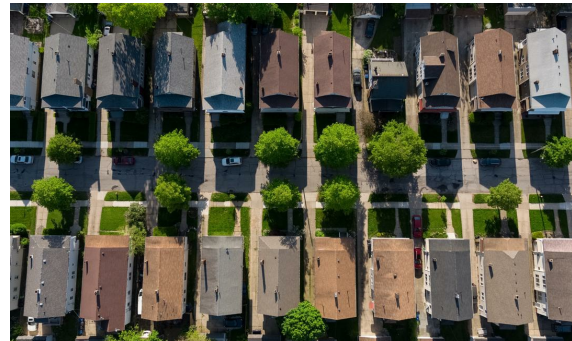

Cuyahoga County celebrated today at a press event the completion of solar panel installations across four County-owned buildings, along with the success of the residential and municipal solar co-ops, and the County's new SolSmart Gold designation. The event, held at the Harvard Ave. Maintenance Garage, was a commemoration of the County's longstanding dedication to clean, renewable energy. The SolSmart Gold designation -- the highest designation offered by SolSmart -- is in recognition of the County's commitment to making it faster, easier, and more affordable to go solar, as well as the work the County has done to reduce costs and encourage solar energy growth at the local level.

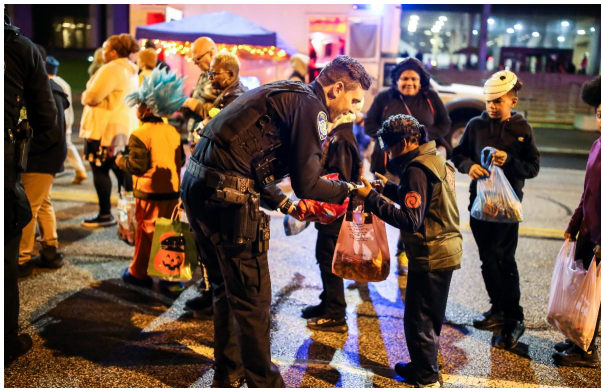


Save Our Homes Month Tax Foreclosure Events
