Latest Report Shows Significant Improvements made in County's Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion Efforts

Cuyahoga County recently released its 2022 Equity Commission Report, which outlines several initiatives aimed at improving equity, diversity, and inclusion across all areas of government. The report also reflects on successful inclusion efforts implemented over the past year and shows the County distributed 215 loans to minority-owned businesses (through the first three quarters of 2021 alone), awarded nearly \$17 million in contracts to small/minority/women-owned

Learn How to Save Money and Energy from Group Solar Purchasing

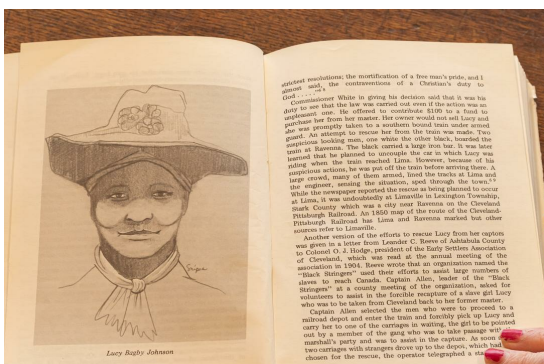
