County and State Partner to Provide Broadband Services to Residents in Least Connected Communities

As part of its long-term strategy for digital inclusion, Cuyahoga County is partnering with the State of Ohio and local non-profit PCs for People, to provide in-home, high-speed internet access to roughly 25,000 Cuyahoga County households in many of the County's least connected communities. The County and the State are investing \$20 million for the project. With the County and State's funding, PCs for People will build a fixed wireless network that can support approximately 20,000 suburban households across 77 census tracts where more than 20% of the population is unconnected and the average income is below the County's Area Median Income.
