Cuyahoga County and local partners have launched a new program to provide resources and connections to support families with young children. FamilySpace is a neighborhood-based hub of programming, information-sharing, and network-building for families with children ages 0 to 5. The first of four planned FamilySpace locations was recently opened during a press event at the Cuyahoga County Public Library in Garfield Heights, and three more FamilySpace programs are expected to open before the end of 2022.
