



Executive Order No. EO2021-0013

RESCINDING PRIOR EXECUTIVE ORDERS RELATED TO THE SPREAD OF COVID-19

WHEREAS, the Governor has rescinded Executive Order 2020-01D Declaring a State of Emergency; and

WHEREAS, while COVID-19 continues to spread throughout the County, with the development and distribution of vaccines, it is appropriate to rescind prior Executive Orders.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Armond Budish, County Executive of Cuyahoga County, Ohio, by virtue of the powers vested in me under Article 18, Section 3 of the Ohio Constitution, by the Charter of Cuyahoga County, and the laws of Cuyahoga County and the State of Ohio, do hereby order and declare as follows:

1. That the following Executive Orders are hereby rescinded:

EO2020-0002, dated March 11, 2020, Declaration of a State of Emergency for Cuyahoga County; and

EO2021-0012, dated June 16, 2021, Declaration and Order Regarding Face Coverings, Social Distancing, and COVID-19 Screening in County Buildings.


2. This Executive Order shall go into immediate effect upon my signature and shall continue in force until it is rescinded.

3. The original copy of this Executive Order shall be filed, as is the case with all Executive Orders, with the Cuyahoga County Department of Law, and a copy shall be filed with the Clerk of County Council.
