



Executive Order No. EO2023-0002

SIGNATURE AUTHORITY

(Amending Executive Order EO2023-0001)

WHEREAS, Section 2.03(6) of the County Charter provides that the County Executive has the power to “execute contracts, conveyances and evidences of indebtedness on behalf of the County;”

WHEREAS, Section 501.03(B) of the County Code provides that the County Executive “may perform any of the functions that he or she may perform under Chapter 501 of the County Code through his or her duly authorized designees;”

WHEREAS, Section 2.03(14) of the County Charter provides that the County Executive has the power to “employ and supervise such number of deputies, assistants and employees as shall be reasonably necessary to assist the County Executive in carrying out the duties of the office.”

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Chris Ronayne, County Executive of the County of Cuyahoga, Ohio, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Charter of Cuyahoga County and the laws of Cuyahoga County and the State of Ohio, do hereby order and direct that:

SECTION 1. Section 4 of Executive Order EO2023-0001 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

SECTION 4.

a. I authorize the Director of Development as my designee to sign all documents related to economic and business development transactions approved by the appropriate county contracting approval authority. The Director of Development may also sign all documents necessary to effectuate releases of properly satisfied mortgages securing economic and business development loans.


b. I authorize the Director of Housing and Community Development as my designee to sign all documents related to housing and community development transactions approved by the appropriate county contracting approval authority. The Director of Housing and Community Development may also sign all documents necessary to effectuate releases of properly satisfied mortgages securing housing and community development loans.

SECTION 2. All other terms and provisions of EO2023-0001 not amended hereby remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. This Executive Order shall go into immediate effect upon my signature and shall remain in force until rescinded by me or any of my successors. The original of this

Executive Order shall be filed with the Cuyahoga County Department of Law and a copy shall be filed with the Clerk of County Council.
