

Executive Order No. EO2016-0003

Mandatory Pre-Bid and Pre-Proposal Conferences

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 701 of the Cuyahoga County Charter mandates that the County "shall develop and implement policies, programs and activities for the expansion and enhancement of economic activity in the County so as to create and preserve jobs and employment opportunities for and available to residents of the County"; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Armond Budish, County Executive of Cuyahoga County, Ohio, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Charter of Cuyahoga County and the laws of the State of Ohio, do hereby order and direct that:

Section 1. The County is hereby required, where reasonably practicable, to conduct a conference open to the public where it will allow prime contractors and subcontractors to interact and the County will explain its needs/wants in advance of the due date for every request for bids, request for proposals and request for qualifications that is issued by the County

Section 2. This Executive Order shall continue in force until rescinded by me or any of my successors.
