

# Executive Order No. EO2018-0001

## SIGNATURE AUTHORITY

### (Supplementing Executive Order EO2015-0001)

WHEREAS, Section 2.03(6) of the County Charter provides that the County Executive has the power to “execute contracts, conveyances and evidences of indebtedness on behalf of the County;”

WHEREAS, Section 501.03(B) of the County Code provides that the County Executive “may perform any of the functions that he or she may perform under Chapter 501 of the County Code through his or her duly authorized designees;”


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Armond Budish, County Executive of the County of Cuyahoga, Ohio, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Charter of Cuyahoga County and the laws of the State of Ohio, do hereby order and direct that:

**SECTION 1.** Executive Order EO2015-0001 is hereby supplemented by this Executive Order.

**SECTION 2.** I authorize the Matt Carroll to sign all documents, including, but not limited to, all contracts, agreements, purchase and sale documents, memoranda of understanding, amendments, grant applications, loan documents, deeds and other conveyance documents, promissory notes, mortgage releases, indentures, loan agreements, bond purchase agreements, plats and drawings, administrative and personnel documents, on behalf of the County Executive.

**SECTION 3.** This Executive Order shall go into immediate effect upon my signature, and shall remain in force until rescinded by me or any of my successors.
