## • General Fund:

**Gross Sales Tax** receipts totaled \$21.7 million in the month of May 2021. Year-to-date, sales tax receipts totaled \$114.3 million, which represents a year over year increase of 1.6%.

## • Health & Human Services Levy:

Revenue generated from the County's **two voted levies for health and human services** is budgeted to be \$287,024,501: \$270.4 million in property taxes and \$16.7 million from the State (homestead credit).

- Attached is the INFOR/Lawson report YEAR-TO-DATE FUND BALANCE by FUND, which summarizes YTD Receipts, YTD Expenditures and Encumbrances for all County funds. Please note:
  - o This YEAR-TO-DATE FUND BALANCE by FUND report has not been audited
  - Several funds have been consolidated (ie: Casino Fund, Auto Title, Coroner's Lab, County Planning Commission have been consolidated to General Fund)
  - o Subfunds have been eliminated
- The Alternative Tax Budget for 2022 has been submitted to County Council. This budget is required by Oho Revised Code and demonstrates our need for property taxes levied by Cuyahoga County. This budget includes:
  - o Schedule 1 detailing our levies and the allocation of inside millage
  - Schedule 2 estimating our resources
  - Schedule 3 detailing our general obligation debts

The Alternative Tax Budget for 2022 is scheduled for the June 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2021 Council meeting.

- As of May 31, 2021, we have spent approximately \$203.7 million of the \$216 million in federal CARES Act funding received in 2020. This includes spending on Council approved programs and payroll for employees substantially dedicated to COVID-19. Not included in this number is \$12.3 million in remaining encumbrances. The deadline for spending CARES Act funds remains December 31, 2021.
- Sales Tax Receipts of \$26.6 million have been reported for June 2021. This is 33% more than this month last year and 6.4% more year over year.
