In accordance with County Code §701.07(C), the following is the monthly update for February 2023.

Gross Sales Tax receipts (before allocation to General Fund and Debt Service) totaled \$26.9 million in the month of February 2022. Year-to-date sales tax receipts totaled \$53.9 million, which represents a year over year increase of 6.0%.

General Fund:

The most significant source of revenue is Sales Taxes. Year-to-date Sales Taxes allocated to the General Fund total \$52.3 million. The following tables summarize General Fund revenues, expenditures and subsidies:

• Significant Changes:

- Council approved appropriations of \$1,009,960 in the Veterans Services Fund. This
 appropriation will be disbursed for one-time services and programs approved in R20220363.
- Council approved a cash transfer of \$311,691.95 from the General Fund to the Veterans Services Fund. This transfer was the surplus or the unspent portion of the Veterans Services Commission's 2022 General Fund budget.
- Council approved appropriations for \$1,750,000 for the Veterans Services Commission headquarters buildout. This includes design and renovation of the future headquarters which will be managed by the Department of Public Works.

- Council approved appropriations of \$1,000,000 for the Workforce Development-Educational Assistance program. This is an annual subsidy funded by the Health and Human Services Levy that was omitted in the 2023 Budget Update.
- Council approved appropriations of \$5,330,812 in Opioid Mitigation Funds. These funds will be used for contract amendments with the Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board (\$4,363,012 for the Diversion Center) and the Cleveland Hitchcock Center (\$967,800 for a new treatment facility for women with substance abuse issues).
