In accordance with County Code §701.07(C), the following is the monthly update for May 2023.

**Gross Sales Tax** receipts (before allocation to General Fund and Debt Service) totaled \$24.3 million in the month of May 2022. Year-to-date sales tax receipts totaled \$135.6 million, which represents a year over year increase of 7.1%.

## General Fund:

The most significant source of revenue is Sales Taxes. Year-to-date Sales Taxes allocated to the General Fund total \$132.4 million. The following tables summarize General Fund revenues, expenditures and subsidies:
